PERTAINING TO THE PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the provisions of C.R.S. 31-16-105 allow any municipality to determine at a regular or special election to meet the requirements of publication of ordinances by publishing ordinance by title only rather than publishing the ordinance in full, and

WHEREAS, the publication of voluminous ordinances is a unnecessary and burdensome expense upon the Town,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone, Colorado, that the following measure shall be referred to the electors of the Town of Crestone, Colorado, at the regular municipal election on April 2, 2002, to-wit:

1. Shall the Board of Trustee of the Town of Crestone, Colorado be allowed to meet the requirements of publication of ordinances contained in Section 31-16-105 of the Colorado Revised Statutes by publishing said ordinances by title only rather than publishing the ordinance in full?

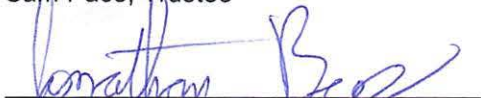

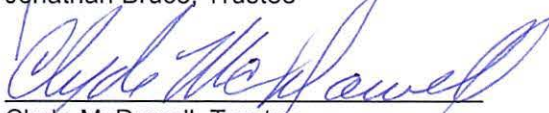

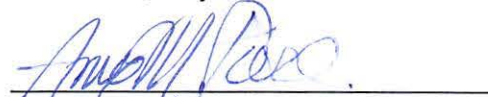

RESOLUTION NO. 001-2002

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CRESTONE,
COLORADO TO ADD AN ITEM TO THE BALLOT OF THE REGULAR ELECTION TO
ELIMINATE THE LIMITATION ON TERMS OF OFFICE**

WHEREAS, Section 11 of Article XVIII of the Colorado Constitution was amended so as to allow statutory towns to eliminate the limitations on terms of office imposed by such Section, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone has considered the impairments to effective government resulting from term limits in the Town of Crestone - which limits discourage the development of experience in local government among the Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deems it in the best interest of the Town to allow the voters to determine whether A Trustee shall remain in office for succeeding terms through the normal election processes rather than being limited by terms of office,

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone that the following issue shall be placed on the ballot of the next regular election on April 2, 2002, to-wit:

1. Shall the Town of Crestone eliminate the limitations on the terms of office of the Mayor and the members of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone, Colorado imposed by Section 11, Article XVIII of the Colorado Constitution?

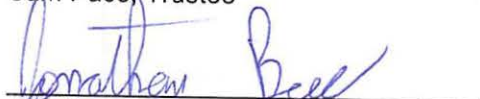

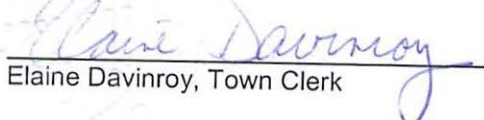
